Project # 139: Fish Bowl

- Create a large fishbowl shape out of construction paper or poster board.
- Create some small various shapes and sizes of different fish. You can cut out your own as well as choose to use some stickers.
- Create a sea of water with the fish in the bowl. You can draw in some wavy lines for the water as well as place your fish into the waves.
- Think about any other features you may want in your fishbowl. Seaweed, rocks etc. can be drawn in or glued in. Tissue paper is nice for this. Bubble paper is also nice for water texture.
- Gather some sand or small pebbles from the beach or buy some clean sand and fishbowl rocks from the pet store.
- Using some white liquid non-toxic glue place some on the bottom of the fish tank shape. Spread the sand or pebbles onto this. Let it dry before picking it up.

Activity:

Go to visit the pet store and view the various types of fish and aquariums. Go to an aquarium for a visit. Take a walk to the river and view the water. Sometimes you may see a fish swimming or jumping.... If you go down a pier especially in the Ocean areas, you may see Starfish attached to rocks. Sometimes when the tide is out, you can walk in the small puddles and see the tiny fish swimming by your feet. Also, there should be crabs and shells of various kinds.

Be respectful of the beach, river and fish in these areas and be gentle. Looking is best rather than touching unless it is a vacant shell.
