Project #141: Bean Planting

- Buy some Pole or bush bean green bean seeds.
- Place a paper towel into a plastic dish such as a recycle container.
- Place some beans onto the paper towel.
- Cover with another paper towel and wet until fairly damp.
- Wait a few days while keeping the paper towels damp. Check the bean seeds occasionally to see if they have sprouted.
- When sprouted, they can be planted into a small compostable pot for the garden or a small recycle container such as a fruit cup. Place soil in the small pot or dish.
- Poke a hole with your finger about 3-5 cm deep.
- Carefully place the sprouted bean into the hole in the soil. Cover lightly with more soil. Add water and keep it moist.
- Place you plant in a sunny area indoors to start with.
- When it grows and sprouts a few leaves, you may transplant it into a larger pot. The sprouted seeds may also be planted directly into a large pot and watch them grow.
