Project #143 Dinosaur Footprints!

- Take some pie plates and create some animal or dinosaur footprint shapes.
- Paint them various colours.
- Take various pie plates and create templates of various kinds of footprints by cutting shapes into the pie plate to resemble the footprints of various dinosaurs and other animals.
- These can be lightly taped to another piece of paper to create a collage of footprints.
- When dry, children can add scenery to the paper such as trees and some dinosaur shapes. See what they come up with. Any version of dinosaur they can draw is creative.
- You may want to use stickers for toddlers or children that prefer this. Try to encourage drawing as this is more creative and does not have to be perfect!
- Trees, grass, and rocks can be draw onto the paper quite easily.
