Project #147: Myself!

- Create some shapes of people.
- Children can choose the design that they like.
- Shapes can be made of various ideas of clothing styles or just basic body with pants, dress, shorts, leggings etc.
- Have the children add details into the picture such as their hair colour and style, eyes, and facial details.
- Add the style and colour of clothing the child is wearing.
- A mirror is a good addition to this project so they can see what they look like. This may inspire the child to draw in the details as they see themselves.
- Depending on the age of the child, you can encourage details such as fingernails, shoes, ears, etc.
- Try adding some 3D items such as tiny sequins for buttons or thin threads for hair using a glue stick.
- You may be able to buy some premade larger shapes of people.
- Maybe have some skirt, pant, tops, dress shapes available to glue onto the larger people shape as well as drawing in details.

Chant:

Mary wore her red pants, red pants, red pants, All Day Long!

Peter wore his blue shirt, blue shirt, blue shirt, All day long!

Children can choose something they are wearing and take turns in the chant!
