Project #149: Wind Lanterns

- Create some rectangle paper by cutting some construction paper in half.
 Use various colours.
- Cut some tissue paper strips of various colours.
- Using a glue stick, children can glue the tissue paper strips onto one long side of the paper strip.
- Another idea is to use some strips of ribbon, shiny paper or any other suitable material that will "Blow" in the wind.
- Children can also draw their own designs onto the paper strip.
- Bingo dabbers could be used to decorate the paper strip as well.
- Try some light-weight stickers.....
- When the strips are glued on and the paper strip is decorated, roll the strip into a tube shape.
- Staple, glue, or tape it in place.
- Punch two holes into the top where there are no paper strips.
- Attach a lightweight string to hang.
- Hang this in a window area where it can blow with the natural breeze.
- Hang them by a fan is another Idea.

Activity:

Go to a Wind Chime store to view some of the wind chimes. Think about how you may be able to create your own wind chimes that have some sound.
