- Cut some petal shapes from various colours of tissue paper.
- Cut some strips of green tissue paper.
- Place the Petal shapes after scrunching them a bit onto a piece of construction paper into a flower shape by using a glue stick. Petals on the gladiola are in a bent fashion.
- Next take your green strips and create the stem.
- Leaves may also be done as well.
- If you wish, you may want to use Bingo Dabbers or felt pens to add some details.
- This is a very "Free Art" type project so be creative with it.
- You may want to add the sun, clouds etc. too to your Picture.
