Project #151: Birds Nest

- Create a Nest Shape from Brown construction paper.
- Add some lines with felts or crayons to resemble some twigs and grass.
- Use some real straw, tissue paper or other small pieces of paper strips to add some details to your nest.
- Next, cut out some plain oval shapes for the baby birds.
- Glue these onto the back of the nest so the baby birds are extending upwards.
- Add some sticker eyes, googly eyes or draw eyes on your baby birds.
- If you have some feathers, glue them onto the baby birds or the nest.
- Sometimes birds use the feathers in their nest too.
- This nest could also be placed onto another piece of construction paper where you may want to add the Mother Bird.

Story: Are you My Mother (by P.D. Eastman)

Activity: Go for a nature walk and look for birds. Note the sounds of birds. Can you see some nests in a tree. Look into the sky. You may see an eagle, crow, sea gulls or other types of smaller birds in the trees.
