Project #157: Hopscotch!

- Using up to 8 pieces of coloured construction paper, draw the numbers 1-8 in large print with a Felt Marker.
- Arrange each paper in the form of a hopscotch. (a sample is below but you can arrange yours in the order you wish)
- Tape them together securely with masking tape on both the front and the back of each paper locking them all together.
- When this is done, you can place your paper Hopscotch on the floor in your home, on the patio, on your carpet or wherever you have a flat surface.
- Please place some masking tape on the back in a circular shape to secure your hopscotch to the ground.
- Children can hop from square to square with one or two feet.
- For older children, they may like to throw a small bean bag onto a number.
- While hopping from square to square they must pick up the small bean bag while stopping briefly and then continue to hop.
- Think of other ways to play the game.....
- Add more decorative designs to your hopscotch.

Activity: Go outdoors and draw your hopscotch on the pavement or wooden surface to create an outdoor activity.
