Project #158: Popscicle Art!

- Using construction paper of various colours, cut out a popscycle or juice bar shape/s.
- Tape a popscycle stick to one side of it to create your popscycle.
- Next, you may want to use some felt markers on it or crayons.
- Add some liquid glue.
- Have a flat dish with some small beads on it (for Preschool age).
- Children can place the glue side of their creation into the dish of the beads.
- For Toddlers, you may want to choose a different dipping rather than the beads as you do not want them accidentally ingesting some of the beads.
- Other ideas could be: Cotton for a cotton candy effect.
- Another idea could be using a glue stick and adding some sparkles.
- Try glitter glue.

Activity:

Make Popscycles from Jello and Juice. Place half liquid jello (Jelly package) and half juice into a popscycle shaped freezing mould. Freeze and when it is ready it should be the consistency of a popscycle.
