Project #161: Heart Flowers

- Cut out some small hearts and stem shapes from construction paper.
- On each heart, write your favorite messages and draw pictures.
- Stickers with messages may be used for decorating the hearts as well especially for children who do not print yet.
- Try some stick flowers or shapes too for your heart designs.
- Cut out some leaf shapes and add to the stem.
- When all of your pieces are ready, use a glue stick to create your bouquet or any shape you like with the hearts together, could even be a caterpillar shape or something else.
- Hearts in the window of a home that you may make from shapes is another idea.
- Maybe it could be your home or hearts in a car window for Fathers Day?
