Project #171: Boats

- Fold a sheet of paper in half.
- Fold corners down to form triangles on each side.
- Cut a thin strip of paper from the fold part of the boat.
- Take the remaining two pieces of the sailboat and fold the strip up from the bottom of the boat to reach the "Sails" (triangles)
- Now you will have to glue the two sides together.
- Next take a half a sheet of the same width of paper and cut it in half again.
- This paper can then be folded and glued to the boat encasing the bottom.
- Trim edges to form the boat bottom.
- Draw windows, designs etc. to your boat.
- The remaining very thin strip may also be used as a "pole" from the sails of the boat. Other pieces may be glued onto the boat for design.
