- Fold an 8.5 x 11inch letter sized paper lengthwise in half.
- Fold one corner down on each side and smooth the edges with fingers.
- Continue folding the edges down as shown on both sides of the folded paper to create a thin triangular airplane shape.
- You may like to staple or glue the inside "pinching part" to hold it together.
- Decorate as you like using markers, crayons, stickers or other details you may think are suitable.

Activity:

Go outside and fly your airplanes. Fly them indoors as well. Have some races with them and see how far they can go. Try small ones and big ones. Try making one by folding the paper in the shorter version...
