Project #175: Octopus

- Using a paper plate, cut about $\frac{1}{4}$ of it off one edge.
- Turn the large piece over and paint it any colour you like.
- Using some construction paper or some tissue rolls of paper (the thicker stretchy type) create strips for the octopus legs.
- Glue each leg onto the large part of the painted pie plate.
- Be creative and attach as many or as little as you like.
- They can also be various types.
- Next tape or staple the small piece of the pie plate on the back for a handle.
- Glue or draw eyes and a mouth on the front for your puppet!
