Project #182: Tigers

- Draw a circle for a face.
- Add some facial details.
- Draw some ear shapes above the face.
- Glue some string or wool around the face for the mane of the tiger.
- Draw an oval shape for the body attached to the head.
- Add some legs and a tail.
- Legs could have some stripe details added as well as the tail and body.
- Add toenail lines for the feet.
- Add whiskers for the face.
- If you like, you could make all the pieces separate and then glue them together to form your tiger.
- If you are making a mural, add some details to your picture such as trees, vines, grasses, flowers, leaves etc.

Activities:

Go outside and look for cats. Compare how the shape is the same as the tiger. You may find tabby cats which are striped like tigers. The large orange tabby cats are almost always the male cats. The calico cats are almost always the female cats.

Visit the pet store or animal shelter to view the cats.
