Project #183: Lizards

- Draw an oval for the head.
- Draw a larger oval for the body.
- Add legs and a tail.
- Add some small ears to the head.
- Add some toenails to the legs.
- Fill in some facial details.
- Add a pattern to the body.
- Make many lizards on your paper and add some scenery to it.
- Use various colours and shaped patterns for your lizards.
- Lizards like to bask in the sun to keep warm.

Activity:

Go to the pet store to view some of the Lizards and Geckos. Talk about what they might eat. Geckos love to eat live Crickets! Geckos can only live with as a male female combination and only two together or they will fight. They must have a proper glass tank with a special light for heat as they are cold blooded. If the female lays an egg, you must take it out immediately and place in a separate tank with proper heating lights. If you do not take it out of the parent's tanks, they may destroy the egg or the hatchling when it arrives. The dominant male may do this to continuously have a mate.
