Project #195: Vehicles

- Start with a plain piece of light coloured poster board or construction paper.
- Use various shapes of sponges dipped into liquid tempera paint to form your vehicle shape onto your paper.
- Let it dry.
- Add details to your creation with felts, pencils, crayons, bingo dabbers or use small thin paint brushes for painting details.
- Other things could be added such as tin foil, cellophane paper, stickers, tissue paper etc.
- Be sure to try to add the doors and window details.
- Add people or animals to your vehicle.
- Create a scene around your vehicle.
- Try making roads, parks, houses, trees, flowers, birds, sky etc.
- Be creative and think of things you would like to add to your vehicles or scenery.

Change the vehicle type as well. Think of variations!
