## Project #197: Fish in a Waterfall

- On a plain piece of white construction paper or poster board, paint some blue and green stripes on your paper. A sponge brush would work nicely for this.
- Paint your hand white and add your hand prints to the bottom of the paper.
- Let this dry.
- Next, paint some fish or you may want to make your fish separately and glue them on with a glue stick.
- Create your fish with some coloured paper and add some details to them such as the colours, eyes, fins.
- Another idea would be to use some sticker fish for the younger toddlers and preschoolers.
- You may want to add some texture to your picture such as glueing a light sprinkling of sand or powder may look like sand.....
