Project #204: Squirrels

- Cut a Squirrel shape out of construction paper.
- Children can add details with felt markers, crayons or pencils for facial and foot details.
- Next, using glue stick or non-toxic liquid white glue, glue on some fur, string, wool or other fabric. White liquid glue works the best.
- For other details, think of various ideas such as googly eyes, sticker eyes, bingo dabbers.
- You may like to make a collage of more squirrels.
- Cut out magazine photos of squirrels and trees, add some tissue paper for details such as grass or leaves.
- Try some paint!
