### Project #206: Felt and Paper Leaves

- Cut a variety of shapes and sizes of paper leaves.
- Use your paper leaf to pin onto felt pieces of Fall colours.
- Cut around the leaf shape to create your felt leaves.
- You may also like to use "Fabric Paint" to squeeze lines onto your felt leaves or to make various colours for your Fall Leaves.
- For paper leaves, draw lines, add colours, use paint or whatever non-toxic idea you may have.
- You may like to sprinkle dry leaf bits onto your paper leaf.
- Think about making a mobile with various leaves hanging from a stick, branch, hanger .....
- Another idea is to make a "Stuffed Leaf" by cutting out two large leaves from thin paper.
- Staple the leaves together leaving an opening.
- Stuff the leaf with your scraps of paper.
- Staple closed and then paint with a variety of colours.

#### Activity: Fall Leaf Walk

Go for a walk, discuss colours of Fall

With Felt pieces, children may hold a colour and bring it to the felt board when the colour is called.

Felt pieces may also be used in the chant: "See Them Falling", refer to previous project for words or make up your own words. Throw leaves!
