Ann's Creative Corner Project #205: Laminate Leaf Matching

- Collect some Fall leaves of various colours.
- Place in between some heavy books and newsprint to get dry and completely flat.
- When dry, have children lay the leaves on sticky CLEAR kitchen shelving paper.
- Cover with another piece of shelving Clear paper. Adults will need to help with this.
- Alternatively, you may want to laminate the leaves that you may glue onto construction paper.
- Wax paper with leaves in between also works well. An adult may place wax paper with leaves in between newspaper and a light cloth on top. IRON WITH HOT IRON; ADULTS ONLY!
- Try to get some matching leaves for the construction paper matching game as shown.
