Project #210: Harvest Apple Trees

- Cut out a tree trunk shape from some brown construction paper.
- Cut out a green tree top shape for the Apple Tree.
- Glue both of these onto another piece of construction paper.
Children can choose the colours of paper.
- Add some apple shapes from paper, drawing, bingo dabbers, cut outs, or magazine pictures of apples.
- Add details to your trunk with lines.
- Add some leaf shapes to your tree.
- Think of other things you may like to draw for your picture such as flowers, sky details, little animals such as squirrels.....
- If you have some apple seeds, glue them onto the paper as well.

Activity: Go to the stores and you will see many apples in bins as it is Apple Season!

Farmer Brown: (use fingers, felt apples on a board, paper apples...)

Farmer Brown has 5 Red Apples hanging from a tree,
5 red apples hanging from a tree'

Along came "Joe" and picked one,
And now there were 4

Farmer Brown has 4 red apples hanging from a tree.....

Continue until all the apples have been picked! Use the childrens names.
