Project #214: Pumpkins, Pumpkins!

- Cut out a pumpkin shape from some orange or yellow construction paper.
- Cut out a variety of shapes and sizes of paper for eyes, nose, mouth, stems etc.
- With a glue stick, glue these shapes on.
- Prior to this, if you like you could draw some details on your pumpkin shape such as the curved lines of the pumpkin.
- Add some leaf shapes as if your pumpkin was in nature.
- Tissue paper is a nice touch to give your Jack O lantern a textured surface.
- Make some smaller pumpkins.
- Create a collage of pumpkins in a field.
- Think of various ways of making your Jack O lantern. Pumpkins are many different shapes and sizes so design it your way.
- Children should be free to design the pumpkin their own way to be creative. It does not have to have all the details or it could have extra details!
- Try painting it!
