

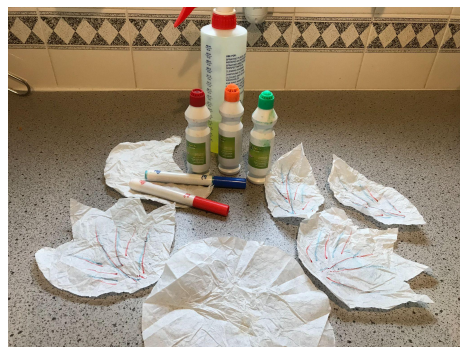
## Ann's Creative Corner

### Project: #219 Coffee Filter Leaves

- Using various coffee filters, cut the shape of leaves. They do not have to be perfect as leaves vary in shapes and sizes. In the Fall, you will also find broken and torn leaves so let the project be natural. Children who can use scissors, can cut their own shapes of leaves.
- Add some details to your leaves with felt markers.
- Add some dabs of colour with non toxic washable bingo dabbers.
- You may like to place them in a plastic tray for the bingo dabbers so the Ink/paint does not get onto the surface underneath the "leaves".
- After you use the felts and bingo dabbers, think about spraying the leaves with some water or coloured water.
- Watch the colours blend.
- Let dry in the pan for awhile.
- Next you could glue them onto a piece of paper, make a mobile with them, place them on a window (very nice to reflect the light).
- Think of other things you could do with them or add to them.... Sparkles, chalk etc.

#### Activity:

Go for a walk and gather leaves that have fallen or simply look and enjoy nature. Rustle your feet through the dry leaves. How does it feel and sound?
