Project #227: Pie Plate Dinosaur

- Cut a paper plate in half.
- Cut some shapes for the dinosaur's long neck and head.
- Cut a long triangular tail shape.
- Cut 4 thick legs with feet.
- Assemble all parts together as shown in the photo below by gluing them together with non-toxic glue. A glue stick works for this.
- When the dinosaur is dry, you may add details with a felt marker, crayons, pencil crayons or pencils.
- Add more details such as maybe googly or sticker eyes.
- Think of other ways to colour your dinosaur. Non Toxic bingo dabbers are good for this.
- Make a variety of dinosaurs by using various sizes of paper plates.
- Attach your dinosaurs to a branch to make a mobile.
- Think about gluing them onto a poster board and making some scenery around them.
- Use some 3D ideas such as tissue paper, soil, grass, straw, string, wool etc.
