Project #228: Community Buildings and Houses

- Cut out various sizes of squares, rectangles and triangles from various colours of construction paper.
- Using a glue stick, glue them onto another piece of construction paper to create your community portrait.
- Add other details with shapes or by drawing things like trees, grass, sky, animals, people, birds.....
- Try using some natural items like real soil and grass for some of the details.
- Think about using cotton for the clouds.
- Try painting some details with a QTip dipped lightly into paint. White is good for sky details and maybe green and brown for the ground details. Trees and grass may be painted for with a QTip.
- Children should create their own as it is their own creativity and ideas. Please be free with this. There is no right or wrong.
- People can be in the house or no people.
- Pets may be or not.
