Project #231: Snow Scene

- Cut out some shapes such as triangles, rectangles, squares, circles, ovals etc.
- Glue these onto some construction paper to form houses for your snow portrait.
- Add details using crayons, felt markers or pencil crayons.
- Next add some texture to your picture using cotton, string, straw or other textured materials.
- The triangles you cut could also be used to form the evergreen trees.
- Add some pine needles to the trees (you may find some below a pine tree if you take a walk)
- Try adding white paint with a QTip.
- Green paint details with a Qtip could also be used for grass, trees and other details.
- Add some sparkles for fun!
- Be creative and make it your own scene!
- Add family and your pets.....
- Are there winter birds? (crows and ducks?)

Activity: Take a winter walk and gather pine cones and other pieces that may have fallen from the winter trees. If you find pine cones, let some dry and place some in water. The ones in water will shrink closed. When dry they open up!
