Project #230: Snowmen

- Cut some Circles of various sizes.
- Using a glue stick to create your snowman by gluing the pieces onto construction paper.
- Use as many or as little of Circles as you like. The circles may be various sizes or all the same dependending on what the children would like to choose. There is no rule regarding the creation of art!
- Next, draw or use scraps of paper for the snowman's hat if you like.
- Add some string, ribbon or threads for the hair is another idea.
- Draw in some details for the face and body. The snowmen are very flexible so you can add what you like to the body of your own snowman.
- You could use shapes for clothing and scarf as well.
- Try drawing some arms and hands. These can be as simple as stick shapes.
- Add some cotton balls for texture. For cotton balls, it is a good idea
 to stretch the cotton as the balls are very compressed. This saves
 the cost and environmental waste of materials. The thinner
 stretched cotton also adheres to the snowman and picture better.
- Add snow around the snowman with cotton or white paint.
- Add some trees and scenery in if you like. Try paint and bingo dabbers.
