Ann's Creative Corner Project #232: Winter Clothing

- Cut out some mitten shapes, scarves and hat shapes from construction paper or poster board.
- Add details with crayons or felt markers as you like.
- Next add some cotton, string, wool or other fabric pieces. (if you choose to add fabric, non-toxic white glue works best to adhere to the paper)
- Bingo dabbers are fun for the children as this is easy and the colours blend to create more colours!
- Add sparkles or sparkle glue.
- With the mittens, try making two out of poster board paper.
- Punch holes into this with a hole puncher.
- Next attach some string or wrapping ribbon (this is a firmer texture).
- Weave the string or wrapping ribbon in and out of the holes to make a design around the mittens. This is great for eye/hand coordination and fine motor control when the children are Preschool age and up.

Activity:

Dress up in your winter gear and go for a walk! If you find snow, build with it! If not, enjoy the weather and note if you are warm enough!
