Project #222: Remembrance Day Poppies

- Create a poppy shape from some red paper. See photo below for some ideas.
- Be creative and add details as you like.
- Tissue paper is nice for this project.
- For younger children a basic poppy shape made from construction paper and gluing some tissue paper onto it is nice to do.
- Use a glue stick and place the glue onto the poppy.
- Add the tissue paper to the poppy either flat or in crumpled pieces for some texture. Try some sparkles.
- Try using Felt Fabric as well or String or Wool.. (you will need white liquid glue for cloth or felt fabric)

Activity: Library

Go to the Library and see what books you may find for Remembrance day. Notice the people selling poppies and buy one. This is by donation and is in support and memory of those who fought for our country.
