Project #235: Stockings!

- Cut out a stocking shape for the younger children or make a tracing template out of strong paper such as a cereal box or poster board. The older children may trace this and cut it out themselves.
 Stockings do not have to be a perfect shape so please let your children be creative.
- Next, attach some tape to the top of the stocking in a strip form to create the top of the stocking.
- Punch two holes into this with a hole puncher. This will not rip as the tape will make it stronger.
- Place a string, ribbon or twine through the holes to create a loop for hanging. Have the children help thread it through (fine motor control practice) and tie it if they are able.
- Decorate your stocking anyway you like. Use felt markers, cotton, sparkles, tissue paper, wool or other things that may stick with a glue stick.
