- Use a variety of materials.
- These can be white paint with small QTips.

- Cut shapes from paper to add a scene of houses and buildings.
- Maybe use some blue paper for some water/ice.
- Tissue paper is nice for this.
- Add some sparkles to your creation!
- Have fun and be free with the project. There is no right or wrong. Let the children do it the way they see it. It can be a full scene or just bits that Toddlers mat like to use.
- Add some natural materials that you may find outside like evergreen tree parts of the greenery.

Activity: Go for a walk to view nature and enjoy it. Feel the crisp or damp air. Build a snowman if there is some snow.
