Project #241: Icicle Art!

- Cut some icicle shaped strips of paper of various sizes and lengths with some side bumpy type look. The children that are capable of using scissors can make these as well. Any triangular shape works for this, not perfect!
- On a piece of construction paper, place your icicles on with glue.
- Children could also glue a house shape onto the paper first or draw a house shape. Icicles can be dangling from the house edges.
- Add some cotton pieces (stretch the cotton to make it thinner for the icicles).
- Paint around with some white paint to increase the snow scene.
- Add other details such as clouds or other outdoor scenery.
- White chalk works well on construction paper too.

Activity: Go for a walk and see if you can find some icicles hanging from structures. Look for some ice on frozen grounds and grass. Look at picture books of icicles. What kind of Birds and other animals like icicles and snow? If you can find icicles, bring them home and watch them melt in a dish or on a piece of paper. Construction paper will show the melting ice very well!
