Ann's Creative Corner Project #244: Penguins and Seals!

- Create templates for seal shapes and penguins.
- Cut out the shapes.
- Using scraps of other paper create circles, ovals and triangles for the details of the Penguins.
- Assemble together onto another piece of construction paper in the way you wish.
- Add some texture to your picture with tissue paper, cotton or other types of paper and soft materials
- Bubble wrap could also be used for this as it could look like Ice cubes!
- Avoid plastic wrap as this is non breathable should it get stuck onto facial areas of children.
- Add more details by drawing onto your portrait!
- Stickers are okay to add to the creation but your own personal touches are more creative.
- Sticker eyes could be beneficial in some pictures. Googly eyes only for older children as they are a choking hazard for younger children and toddlers.
- Create water with the tissue paper and the sky with the tissue paper. Snow from the cotton of course.

Activities:

Read books on Penguin and Seals. Learn where they live, What they eat etc. Visit the Vancouver Aquarium if possible to see the Water creatures.
