Project #247: Ice Cream Cones!

- Create a triangular cone shape and cut it out.
- Cut out various sizes of circles of different colours.
- Reshape the circles to look a little irregular.
- On another piece of construction paper, glue the cone shape on first.
- Children can then add as many different colours of "Ice Cream" they like.
- Be flexible, the ice can be big or small, straight or lop-sided.
- Next add some "Sprinkles" using some sparkles or paper shreadings or.....
- Try dabbing white paint onto your ice cream with a QTip.
- Cotton is another great idea!
- Make many Ice Cream Cones and hang them as a Mobile on a stick, straw, pipe cleaner.

Activity:

Go to the store and buy some ice cream and cones and make ice cream cones at home. Maybe make a banana split with ice cream, bananas and some syrup. Add some sprinkles..... If there are no allergies to nuts, you could also add some crushed nuts.
