Ann's Creative Corner Project #249: Prints and Paint!

- Place some various colours of non toxic liquid paint into some flat trays or non breakable plastic containers.
- Using the three primary colours of red, blue and yellow are a good start as when they are mixed they create the secondary colours.
- Using some containers such as a fruit cup, margarine container, tin can, cookie cutters and other non breakable items for dipping into the paint.
- Press the print onto some paper or cardboard.
- You also like to use small paint brushes to mix the colours onto the paper. This is a very open ended project so children can explore the items, colours and mixing as they like. Process not Product! It will be interesting to see after all is done!
- Add some texture to your painting with some tissue paper, sparkles, sand or other fine items you may have.

Activity: Playing with colourful hoops, balls, nets.

Think of things to do with some colourful toys. You may like to throw a small bean bag or ball through the hoop, into the net, etc. If you have some chalk, make some circles or other shapes on the ground. Make up some games or just colour the pavement in any way you like.
