### Project #258 Puppy Puppets!

- Find a puppy shape for the head of your puppet and cut it out.
- Have the children glue this onto a piece of construction paper with a glue stick.
- Children can then colour the shape in with Felt markers, crayons or pencils.
- Sticker or Googly eyes could be used.
- Add some "fur" with string, wool, cotton etc by glueing on using a glue stick. (children should put the glue all over the puppy head shape before starting to place the String, wool or cotton onto the puppy head shape. (if they use glue after, it may make the other pieces of wool etc pull off and this can be frustrating to the children as well)
- Next, an adult or older child can use some strong tape to tape a tongue depressor stick or popsicle stick onto the back of the puppet!
- Give your puppet a name and write it on the back! Add a few stickers.

### Activity: Puppet Show!

Children and adults can create a puppet show with their creation. It can be behind something or just sitting in a circle. This is a great way to help your children express themselves verbally as well as emotionally.
