Ann's Creative Corner Project #259: Tools and Gadgets

- Create a variety of tool shapes.
- Cut out from cardboard or other types of paper. Cardboard is good as the "Tools" will be stronger and children may pretend play with them.
- Colour these tools in anyway you like; bingo dabbers, Felt markers, crayons, pencils etc.
- Try making a mobile of tools by making smaller shapes and hanging them from a straw. Place some tape on one end of the "Tool" you made and then punch a hole. This will make the hole stronger so the paper ones do not rip. If using cardboard, it is probably strong enough to punch holes in.
- Attach the string to the tool and the straw and tie to make a mobile.
- Try using different types of shiny paper to glue onto your tool. Tin foil, bubble paper, tissue paper, wax paper etc.
