Project #253: Valentines!

- Create various sizes of Heart Shapes by folding your paper in half and cutting or drawing a curved line to form your hearts.
- Open up and you will see your Heart Shape. These shapes can vary in size and shapes. Some may be short and wide or long and thin, small or big.....
- Glue the valentines together to make a layered look.
- Glue the valentines in a row.
- Make a mobile if you like by hanging the Valentines from a stick with string.
- Be creative and decorate your Heart anyway you wish.
- Trimming edges with a pinking type shear may be good for older children. This will make a jagged edge.
- Try making a wavy edge.
- Add some dollies to your Valentine.
- Add some sparkles or stickers.
- Tissue paper and shiny paper.
- Ribbons and bow.
- Add some Stickers maybe.
