

## **Ann's Creative Corner**

### **Project #250: Chinese New Year Tigers!**

(project by Kids Care Preschool)

- Cut out the pieces as shown below, large circle for head, small circles for eyes, snout piece, ear pieces and stripes and whiskers.
- Assemble all pieces together to form the face of the tiger.
- Add details with other forms such as sticker eyes, felt markers, crayons etc.
- When you are done creating the head of the tiger, glue this onto a long firm strip of construction paper doubled or a long strip of poster board.
- When dry enough, place the headband on the child's head and measure it to fit.
- Use tape, glue or staples to secure the headband size in place.
- Alternatives can be using some wool or string to glue on for the stripes and whiskers. White liquid glue works best for fabric and wool.

#### **Activity: Chinese New Year Parade!**

Have the children form a line for a parade. They can wear the tiger headband and dress in traditional Chinese clothing if available. Play instruments while doing your parade. Drums, jingle, tambourine and other instruments could be used!
