Ann's Creative Corner Project #255: Valentines Photo Frames

- Cut out a photo print size of the poster board of the photo you would like to insert.
- Next using the same size of paper or foam cut out another to fit on top of the poster board.
- Draw a heart shape into the centre of the foam/paper shape and cut out.
- Adults can then attach the two pieces together with White Glue or staples but leave an opening to slot a photo in. You may need to trim your photo to fit.
- Children can decorate the edges around the heart with sequins, Rhinestones, glitter, felt markers, beads or other items which are suitable for the age of the child or toddler. Try not to over guide the children on this project as it is their creation. Just be careful to only decorate around the heart shape so the photo or picture can still slide into place.
- When all is done and dry, place your photo or picture into the slot.
- Wrap this up in some tissue paper as a gift for Mom, Dad, friends or other Family Members.
