Project #270: Pot of Gold!

- Create a Pot shape by folding your construction paper in half. Create the shape by cutting on the fold to the desired shape. The pot can be long, short, tall, fat, skinny. Let your children decide on the style of the pot.
- Older children may be able to do this themselves.
- Some Preschool Children may be able to cut on the lines if you draw the shape with a thick felt marker.
- Once you have your pots, make a curved line to create the inside of the pot.
- Write or have children write on it Pot of Gold.
- Next, rip up some yellow tissue paper and scrunch it up. Children can then glue this onto the pot shape. It can go anywhere on the pot shape but is most likely at the top where the bowl is open. But do not advise the child too much as it is the Process not the Product, especially with younger Preschoolers and Toddlers.
- Add some golden sparkles if you have some. Glue stick with a shaker of sparkles works well with this project.

Activity: Go to a shopping area and see what you can see. You will find the clovers and the pot of gold. Rainbows and Leprechauns too!
