- Create a Clover shape or purchase some.
- Children can then add some tissue paper for texture.
- Felt markers and crayons could be used.
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- Bingo Dabbers, stickers or paint could also be used.
- Try some sparkles; look for some green sparkles either in liquid form or in a sprinkle form. Glue stick is fine for a shaker of sparkles. Liquid sparkles may be easier for younger children and toddlers.
- Add other paper such as doilies. You may be able to find these in the Dollar Store in the shape of the clover.
- Try attaching a string to your Shamrock. Hang it on a door knob or on the wall.
- Make a cluster of Shamrocks on a piece of paper using smaller pieces like a garden of Shamrocks.

Activity:

Take a walk and you may be able to find some clover growing. If not now, look a little later in the spring. Bring your shamrocks with you for the Clover Hunt! If you find a 4 leaf clover it is good luck!
