Ann's Creative Corner Project #274: 3D Flowers

- Fold coloured construction paper in half Crosswise.
- Cut Strips of various widths or similar widths. (it doesn't have to be perfect!)
- Using some of the coloured strips fold over in a loop and pinch together at the ends.
- Using three of these "pinched loops" Staple them or glue them together to hold the partial Flower Shape.
- Two of these "Bunches" can then be stapled or glued together to make the flower. Try 3 sections as well if you want a fuller bloom of your flowers.
- Next use some green strips with loops for the stems.
- Fold the green loops over a fairly thick piece of green construction paper (maybe doubled). Staple or glue two or maybe four leaves onto the stem.
- Attach your flower to the stem with staples or glue again.
- Children can then add tissue paper, felt markers, sparkle or other materials that may be suitable to glue onto the flower and stem.

Action chant: (change colours as you like)(Tune: Are you Sleeping) See them growing, See them Growing From the Ground, From the ground. Pink and Yellow, Green and White Pink and Yellow, Green and White. Green and white, Green and White.
