Project #262: Parrots

- Cut out a parrot shape from some fairly strong paper such as poster board or some heavier construction paper.
- Have a variety of Coloured Feathers, Felt markers, Crayons, Bingo Dabbers available for the children to choose.
- Add some details to your parrot with the Felts and Crayons.
- Next try the bingo dabbers.
- After this is dry, use a glue stick to glue some feathers onto your parrot.
- Be sure to give your parrot an eye or two.
- Some parrots have tufts of feathers on top of their head, so it is a thought to add some very small and wispy pieces of feathers to the head.
- Let the children be creative as it is their project and not the adults. Parrots come in all sizes and shapes with many colours and textures so be free with the art.
- Maybe think about making a perch under the parrot.
- Glue the parrot onto another piece of paper and add other details.....

Activity:

Go to a Bird Sanctuary if you know of one. Parrots like to keep warm so you may have to go to an indoor area to see them. Pet stores may have them. A conservatory such as Queen Elizabeth Park may have parrots.
