Project #272: Spring Booklets!

- Make a small booklet by folding a piece of construction paper into 4's.
- Staple one folded side.
- Trim the other folded side and you should have a booklet!
- For the cover of the booklet, create a flower from various shapes and felt markers.
- Put your name on the cover of the booklet
- Fold back each page of the booklet to form a secure crease for each page.
- For all of the pages, you may like to glue in more flower shapes or you may like to draw them as well.
- Try cutting out magazine pictures of flowers and glue them in with a glue stick.
- Glue sticks are best for this project so the pages do not get too sticky. Let each page dry before turning to the next page so they don't stick together.
- For older children, they may like to write down a name for each flower or the colour or what they want to call the Flower.
