Project #273: Spring Tissue and Paper Trees!

- Using a pre-printed paper blank tree trunk, glue this onto a piece of construction paper.
- With scraps of paper, cut out some leaf shapes.
- Rip up various colours of tissue paper and scrunch into small balls as well.
- With a glue stick, cover your tree branches with the glue.
- After this, place the leaves you created from the scraps of paper onto the tree.
- Next you may like to add the "Blossoms" with the scrunched tissue paper. Green Scrunched paper could also be used as leaves.
- What else can you do to your picture? Think of some other things like birds, sky, clouds etc.
- If you want a rainy picture add some raindrops.
- Maybe it is sunny and rainy and there is a "Rainbow"
- Children can create this in any way they like as it is their project and "Beauty is in the eye of the Beholder!"

Activity:

Go to a Farm Nursery and see the Trees that they are growing.

Take a walk in a park and look for the buds and trees.

Cherry Blossoms in a photo may be nice until you see the trees in bloom!
