(Project by Kids Care Preschool)

### **Project #263: Cats!**

- Fold a rectangle piece of construction paper or other fairly heavy paper in half.
- Cut a "U" shaped piece out of the open edge.
- Use this piece for the head of your cat!
- Cut some triangles for the ears, plus a smaller pink triangle for the inner ear.
- Cut a small triangular pink nose shape.
- Cut two ovals for the eyes.
- Assemble all pieces together as shown.
- Add details with felt markers.
- Add some thin strips of paper for the whiskers.
- Draw as many other details as you like; toes, mouth, fur etc.
- Think about adding some wool to your cat to make the fur!
- Add a tail from the same type of paper or the tail could also be of wool, string or other types of paper.

### **Activity: Cat Movements**

- Stretch your body like a cat. On hands and knees do the cat stretch by stretching your back up and down.
- Walk like a cat, quiet and stealthily.
- Curl up like a cat.
- Play with toys like a cat.
- Think of other things that cats like to do!
