Project #271: Spring Finger Print Flowers

- Pour some non-toxic liquid paint into a shallow pan
- Dip your finger into the paint.
- Make some fingerprints on a piece of construction paper.
- Try using various colours.
- Let Dry.
- When dry, add some more details by painting the stems and leaves with a QTip or thin paint brush.
- Alternatively, you may try some felt markers, crayons, pencil crayons or chalk,
- If you decide to make a garden on the bottom of your paper you may like to make a sky at the top, trees, houses or other things for your piece of art!
