- Create a Bunny shape and cut it out for the children.
- Add some details to your bunny with felt markers and crayons.
- Try using some sticker eyes or googly eyes for the face.
- Does a bunny have whiskers and a little pink nose?
- What about the ears? Maybe there is a little pink inside the ears.
- When done your drawings attach some cotton balls for the "Fur" of the bunny. If you stretch the cotton balls it will be less waste and be very nice for the bunnies fur.
- Maybe the bunny is holding an Egg Shape. Glue onto the bunnies paws.
- You could make many bunnies of a smaller size and put them on a piece of construction paper as a collage or bunnies in the grass.
 Add some grass with shapes or tissue paper first or second.
- Add some sky details such as clouds and the sun.

Action Chant: "Robbie the Rabbit" (Crouch down to start)

Robbie the rabbit is fat, fat, fat (hold arms to form a big stomach)
His soft little paws go pat, pat, (pat with hands onto the floor)
His soft little ears go flop, flop, flop (hold arms and hands to form ears and flop motion)

And when he runs he goes hop, hop, hop. (hop around)
