Project #280: Easter Baskets

- Create a Basket Shape from some construction paper or poster board.
- Cut this shape out and if you like, make two pieces.
- If you have two pieces, staple, glue or tape the two baskets together leaving an opening at the top to slot eggs into.
- Draw in some details for the lines of the basket.
- Add some stickers or draw other things on the body of your basket.
- Next, make some egg shaped paper and decorate as you like. You could use felt markers, crayons, chaulk, sparkles, shiny paper, stickers etc.
- Add the eggs to the basket by glueing some onto the top outside piece and the back of the other piece.
- Other "Eggs" could go inside the basket!.

Activity: Make a Felt Story

Create egg shapes from felt and add some details with fabric paint or use a glue gun (very hot) to stick on your decorations for the eggs. Create a Basket using two pieces of felt just as your paper basket.

Story:

The Colourful Egg Hunt has begun, Easter Bunny is looking for fun. The Easter Bunny is looking for an egg the colour of Red Etc. Place eggs into the basket or on top as you go. Children can have turns with their own egg and bring the right colour of egg to the basket.
